

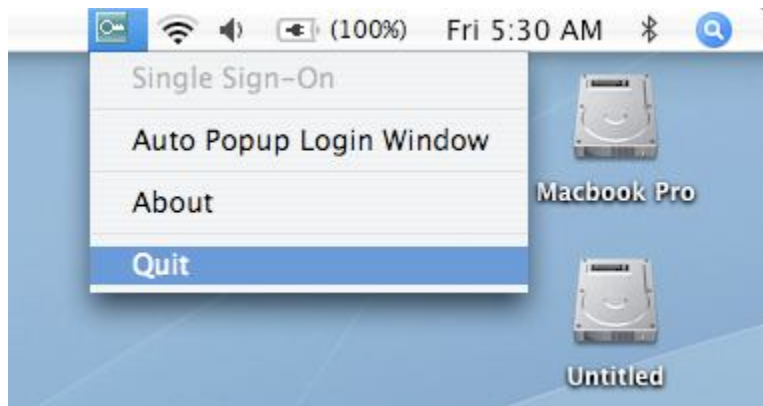
Uninstall Cisco Clean Access Agent:

Mac OS X

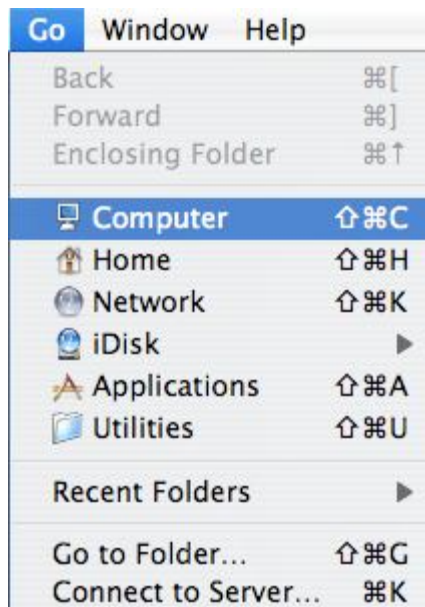
To uninstall the Clean Access Agent on Mac OS X, the following items must be completed:

1. Make sure the Cisco Clean Access Agent is not running.
2. Drag the Clean Access Agent application to the trash can. The Agent application is located in **/Library/Application Support/Cisco Systems/CCAAgent.app**.
3. Drag the Clean Access Agent installation receipt to the trash can. The receipt is located in **/Library/Receipts/CCAAgent.pkg**.

Step 1: Make sure the Cisco Clean Access Agent is not running. If the icon appears at the top on the menu bar, click and select **Quit**.

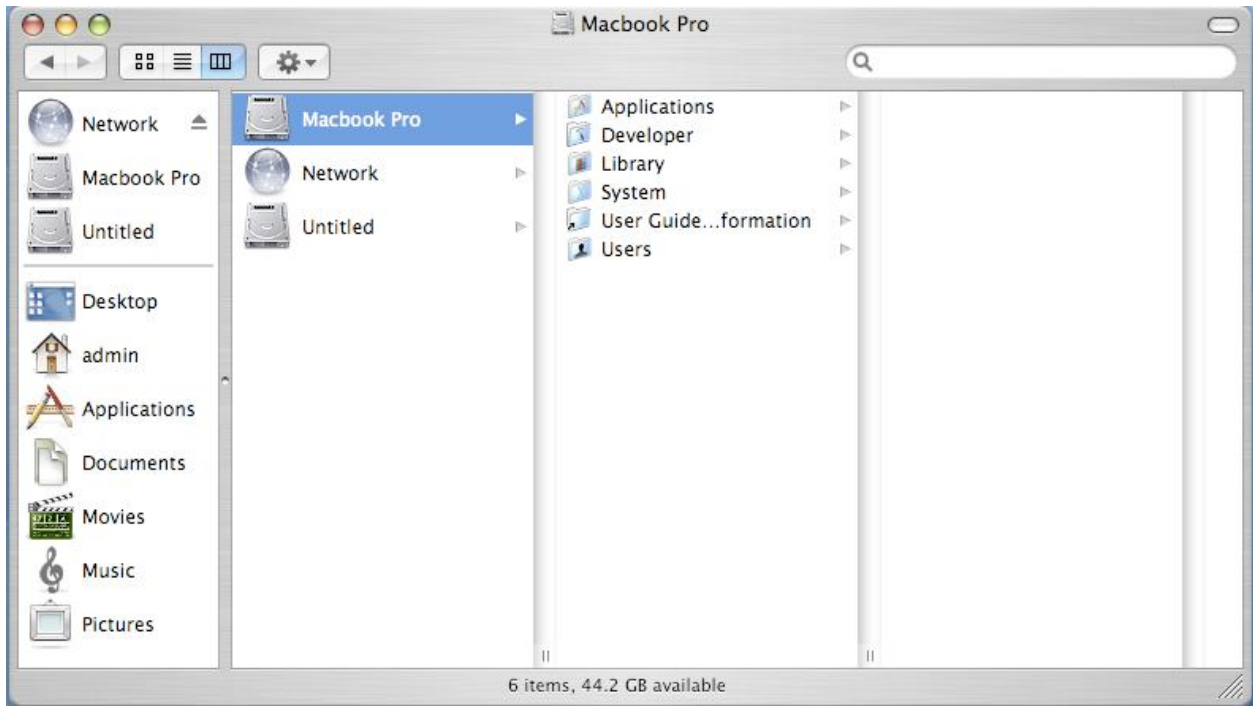


Step 2: Click on Go → Computer to bring up the Finder window.

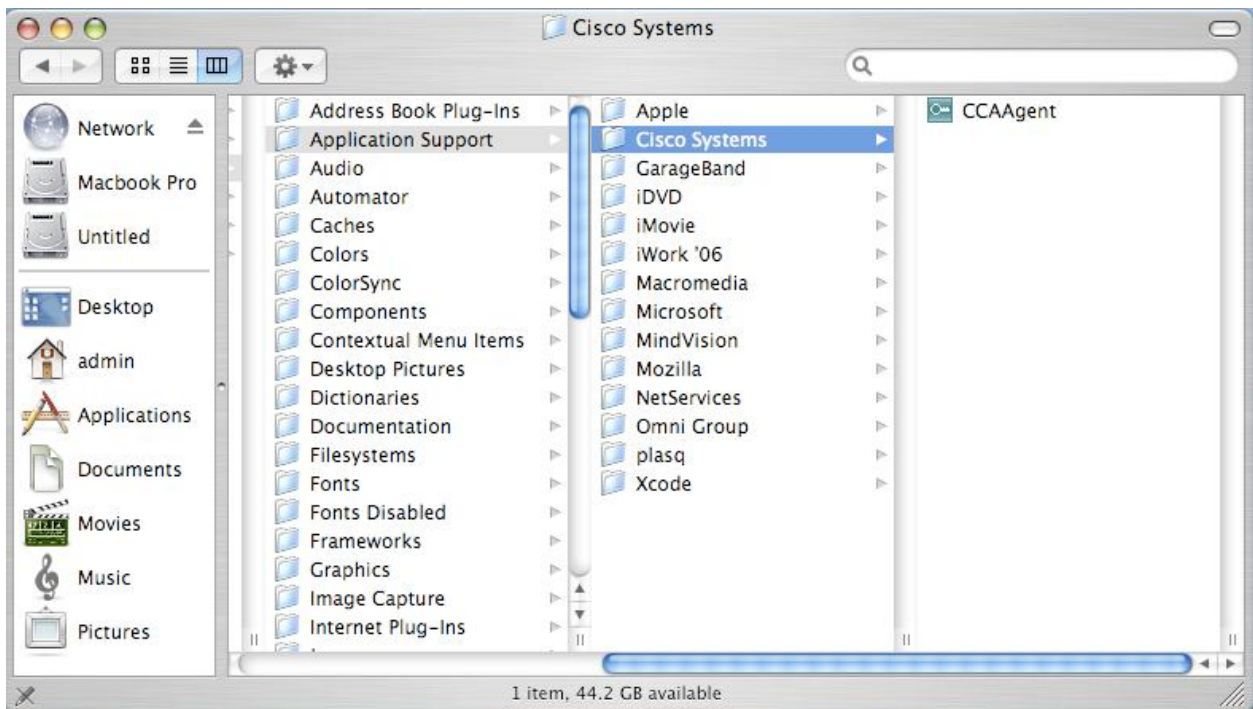

Step 3: Select your hard drive.

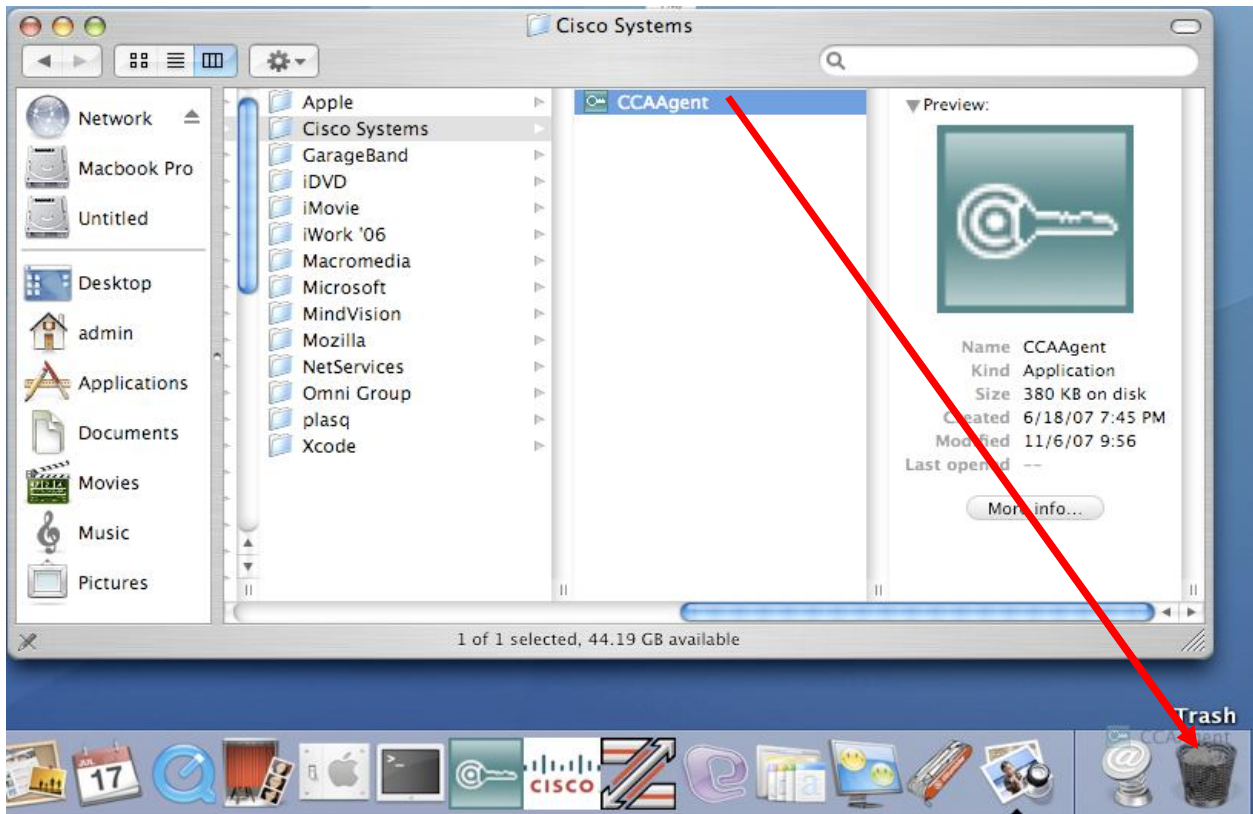


Step 4: Navigate to Library → Application Support → Cisco Systems → CCAgent.app.

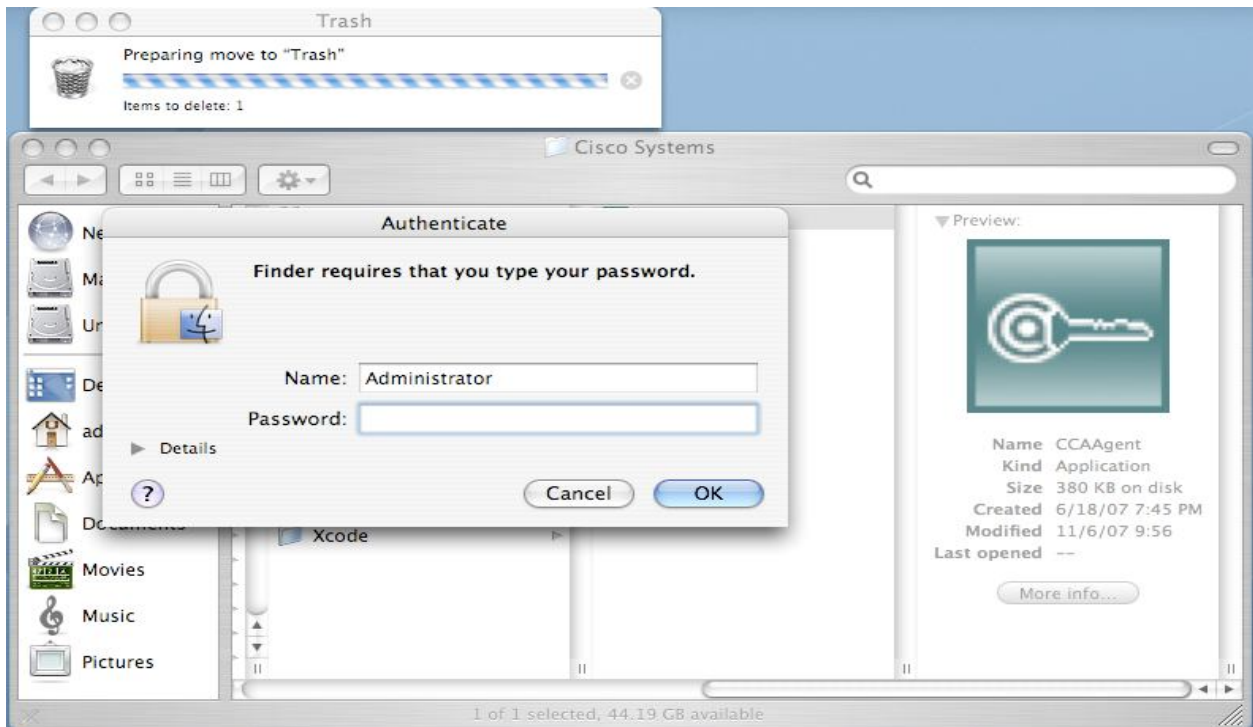

Step 5: Click on CCAgent and send it to the trash.

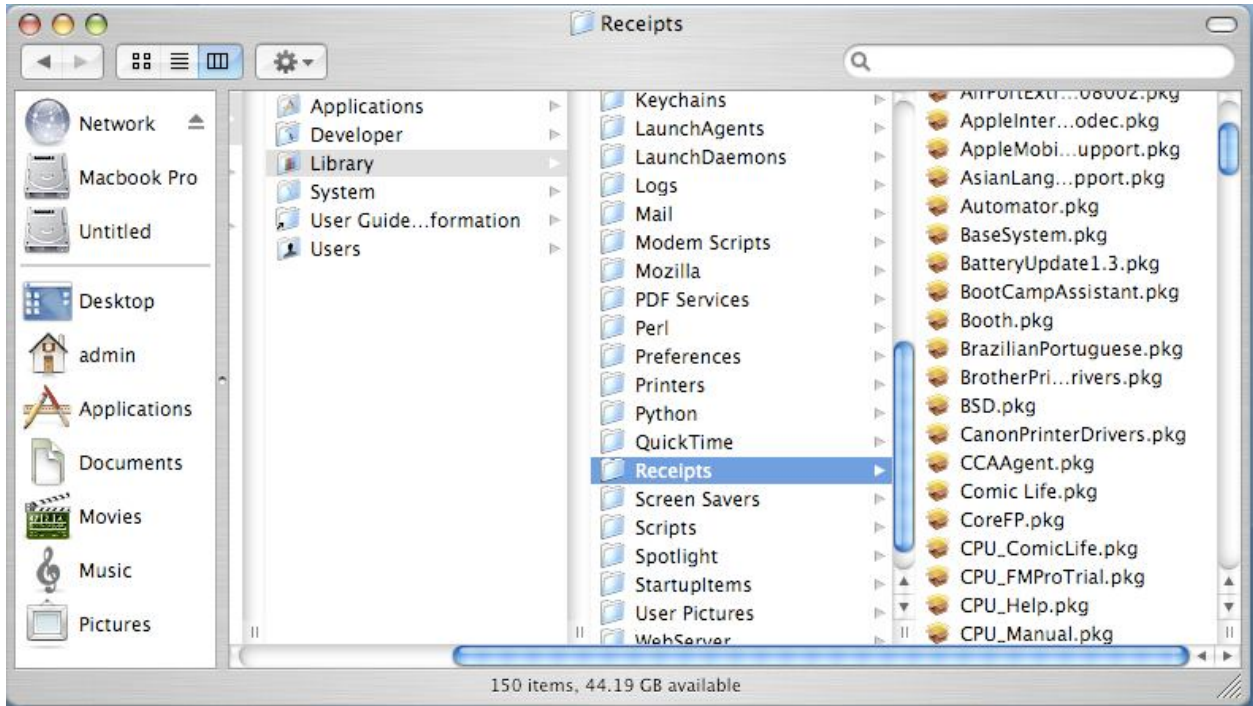


Step 6: Enter your system password to confirm the deletion.
